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MALLORCA and Ibiza may attract the jet set, but Menorca — also right off the coast of Spain — keeps a low profile.

And high standards.

The tranquil 82-room, five-star La Quinta Resort Hotel & Spa, near the town of Ciutadella, despite its state-of-the-art spa and manicured gardens filled with tweeting birds, keeps quietly off the radar.

Yet the resort has all its chakras aligned. From front desk to spa, staff are unblinkingly attentive. Guests emerge from the cobalt-blue spa after powerful Vichy water treatments and hot-stone massages to nibble on Mahon cheese. Others sip gin and tonics or skim around the pool.

Best of all, while late-season windy days only hover in the low-70s, the price for such luxury dips to about \$105 per-person, per-night — including the shuttle to a pretty beach minutes away (www.laquintamenorca.com).
